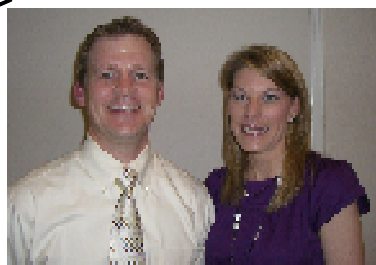
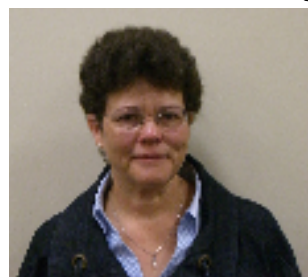

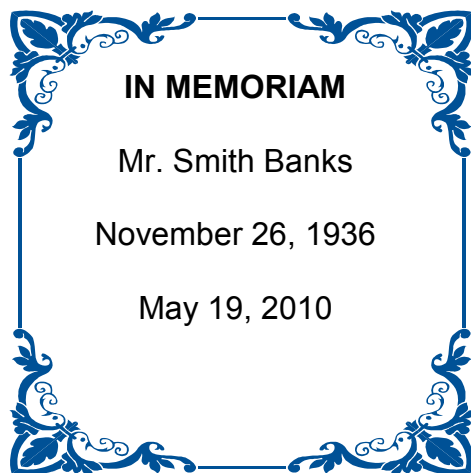

I announced last Sunday that our capital campaign pledge total had grown to \$2,078,313, representing 216 pledges from our congregation. Please remember that we decided to commence with the sanctuary only if we received \$4.4 million in pledges, so it will be exciting to see what pledges are submitted this week and next Sunday as our deadline of May 30 draws near. In the last campaign, we received 471 pledges, so we are more than 250 pledges short of that number for this time. Many families will pledge in this last week, and our hope is that we can receive approximately the same number of pledges for this campaign as we did for the last.

In order to build a new sanctuary, it will take all of us working together. No gift is unimportant or insignificant, and wide spread participation throughout the entire First Baptist family is needed to increase the number of pledges and to reach our goal. If you haven't yet made a pledge to this important project, I trust that you will continue to search God's heart in the matter and join with the hundreds of other families in our church who sense God's leadership for this great step of faith. God has blessed First Baptist Church with a growing congregation badly in need of more space, and He has provided the resources that we have. My prayer and hope is that we will do all that God wants us to do, knowing that our work is to be done for His glory and honor. Lives are being changed each day through the ministry of First Baptist Church, so let's keep moving forward in faith.

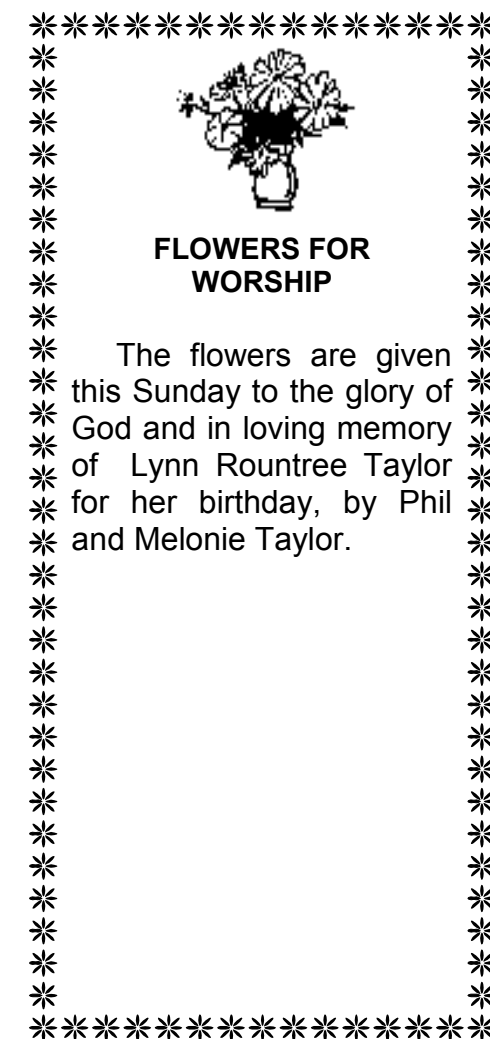

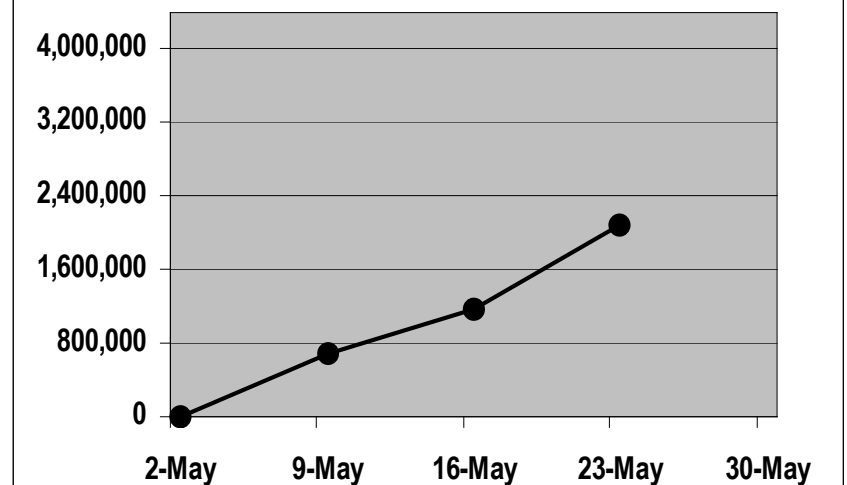
