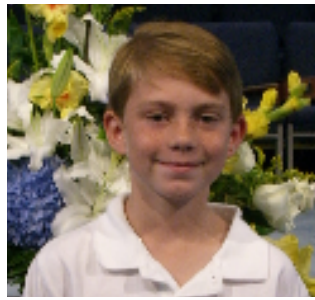

I have been in Orlando, Florida, this week attending the annual meeting of the Southern Baptist Convention.
