### General Information

#### Location:

FBC Preschool is located on the first floor of the "Kidz Place" building at Statesboro First Baptist Church, 108 North Main Street.

#### Hours of operation:

The children arrive at 8:30 am and are picked up by 12:00 noon. Classes begin in mid August and conclude in mid May.

#### Curriculum:

We teach the "Wee Learn" curriculum. Each unit provides guidance and activities to help each child develop language, reading, writing, and math skills appropriate for his/her stage of development. This curriculum also provides activities necessary for physical, mental, social, emotional, and spiritual development.
