From the Pastor

100 Days of Prayer

In a few weeks, our church will begin a spiritual process called "100 Days of Prayer" as we seek to clarify God's vision for First Baptist Church Statesboro. Prior to making any organizational decisions about the strategy, staffing, and structure of our church, we need to seek God's heart corporately through prayer, allowing Him to direct our thoughts, plans, and dreams.

If you want to participate in this spiritual process, choose two other persons to form a prayer triplet that will meet during the 100 day period from January 27 through May 6. Each prayer triplet commits to meeting personally at least once every ten days during the 100 day period. A printed prayer guide will be given to each prayer triplet to use for their ten meetings, which will take about 60 minutes each time. We ask that triplets be either all male or all female, so that men are praying with men, and women with women.

Our goal is to have 100 prayer triplets, consisting of 300 people from all segments of our congregation. We want participation to be deep and wide, so please join this church wide spiritual process and form a prayer triplet for the 100 Days of Prayer. And I look forward to seeing you and your prayer partners at the launch/orientation meeting on January 27 at 6:00 pm in the Perry Fellowship Hall.
