From the Pastor

7 Marks of a Disciple

Today we examine the fifth mark of a disciple, which is "obeying Jesus." When Jesus said to "follow Me," He called His disciples not only to learn from Him, but also to obey His teachings. Many rightly called Him "rabbi," acknowledging that His followers were to conform and obey His instructions, just as students follow a rabbi.

Even today, if we are disciples and followers of Jesus, our lives must demonstrate obedience to His Word. Perhaps no greater disservice is done to non-believers than when Christians profess to follow Jesus but fail to demonstrate obedience in their daily lives. Today we will explore what it means to follow Jesus by obeying Him.

Fair Workers Ministry

For many years, our church has served the fair workers who come to town annually for the Kiwanis Ogeechee Fair. Through your generosity, we distribute pillows and blankets, and we provide a steak luncheon on-site for all fair workers. We also work with medical and dental offices to provide care for the workers and their families while they are in town. These acts of service provide opportunities for Gospel conversations, where we share the wonderful news of Jesus.

Indeed, a disciple-making church is also a serving church, and the manner in which we serve the fair workers demonstrates our commitment to the Great Commandment and the Great Commission. Thank you for being the kind of church that makes disciples because you love God with all your heart, and you love your neighbor too.
